Care

CLEANING

Platinum silicone is non-porous, body-safe, and easy to clean. Wash with warm water and mild, unscented soap after each use. Pay attention to any textures or crevices and rinse thoroughly to avoid soap residue.

For deeper cleaning, you can boil it for 3–5 minutes or run it through the top rack of the dishwasher (no detergent). If the toy is heavy and rests against the dishwasher rack during the cycle, it may develop a temporary crease. To avoid this, position it so it's fully supported and not pressing against anything.

Always let your toy dry completely before storing.

STORAGE

Before storing, make sure your toy is thoroughly cleaned and completely dry.

Store each toy in its own cotton bag to protect it from dust, damage, and chemical reactions.

Avoid letting your silicone toys touch other toys, especially those made from PVC or other plastics. These materials leach oils and chemicals over time — even while just sitting together.

Not only can they damage your silicone toy, but they also release substances that are unsafe for your body.

To keep your toys in top condition, store them separately and safely.

LUBE

Use plenty of water-based lube — we recommend FFausten or X-Lube for smooth, body-safe glide.

Grease-based lubes like Elbow Grease or Crisco are also great options, especially for long-term wear, as they last longer and reduce friction over time. Just note: they're harder to clean off.

✗ Do not use silicone-based lubricants.
