Area of Focus / Skillset: Toys

Supplies

- Scent free, degreasing dish detergent
- Scrubbing tools: wash cloths, silicone scrubbers, loofahs, sponge, etc.
- Dry towels

Tips / Advice

To prevent mold growth, remove the toy from any wet area and dry with a towel before storing.

Once mold has penetrated a toy, there is no way to remove it. It can be killed/deactivated with heat.

Steps / Procedures

To wash toys after use:

1. Rinse toy thoroughly to remove as much excess residual lube as possible. Options for initial rinse may include:
 - Handheld shower head or faucet sprayer
 - Douche nozzle set to high velocity force
 - Silicone scrubbers, sponge, loofah or wash cloths
2. Apply soap and water and rub gently with hands or cleaning tool such as a silicone scrubber. Appropriate soaps may include:
 - **Dawn Unscented Free and Clear** | Useful for alphabet lubes (J, K, X, FFäusten) and oil-based lubes (such as shortening [Crisco, Trex, etc.] and petrolatum).
 - **Dawn Powerwash Free and Clear** | Useful for alphabet lubes (J, K, X, FFäusten).
3. Rinse and repeat until all residual lube has been removed.
4. Remove from wet areas and dry thoroughly before storing.
